Cronin-Massapoag Land

The 30 acres of connecting parcels off Island Pond Road includes a 16-acre parcel, partially in Tyngsboro, donated by the Massapoag Rod and Gun Club in 1996, and Upper Massapoag Pond and its surrounding upland. A 14-acre parcel, donated by John and Jeremiah Cronin in 1996, includes a stretch of the old Red Line railroad bed.

There are trails marked along the Red Line Path stretch, extending from Island Pond Road (entrance to GCT property) to the Cow Pond Road end.



The Red Line Path trail also connects with the Esker Trail of the east parcel of Gamlin Crystal Springs. Green Groton Trails Network blazes highlight the path. Parking to access the east parcel and its trail, the Gamlin Esker Trail, is at the very end of Cow Pond Brook Rd., past the Town Transfer Station, where there is a road gate. See map below.
